

Wireless Configuration Instructions for Android v2.2

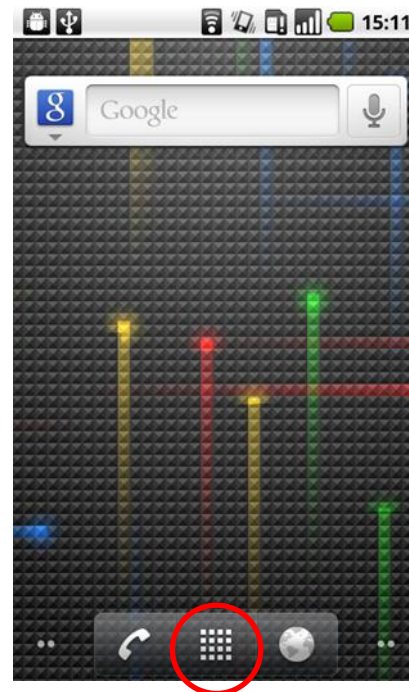
These instructions will configure your wireless connection to the RU-Secure wireless network. It will allow you to authenticate and browse using a higher level of security and protection. It will also automatically log you in after your first connection – no need to login and authenticate every time you come onto campus.

NOTE: These instructions will assume you have Android version 2.2 on your device. If you are unsure of your version number you can check it by performing steps 1 & 2 below, and then click “About Phone”. You will see the Android Version number.

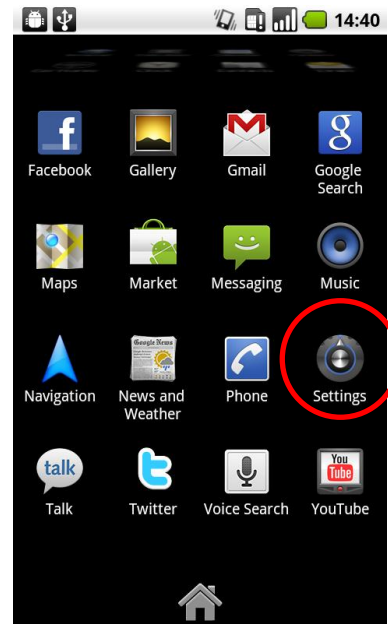
Instruction

1. From your home screen, press the **Menu** button to bring up all the menu options.

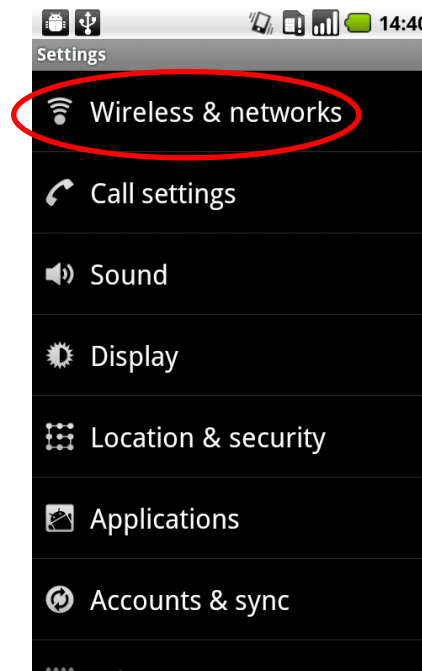

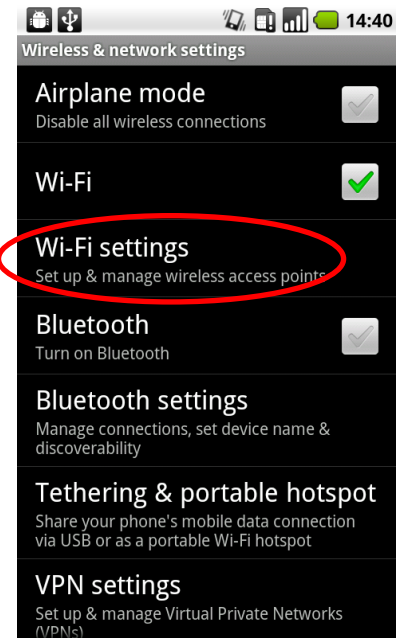
- From the Menu screen, click on the **Settings** icon to open it.



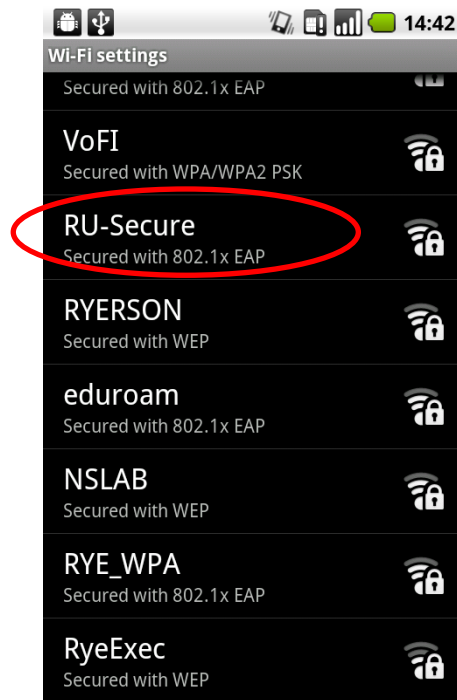
- In the Settings menu click **Wireless & networks**.



4. Click on **Wi-Fi Settings**.



5. In the Wi-Fi Settings menu scroll the listed wireless networks to find **RU-Secure**. Click on it to begin the connection.



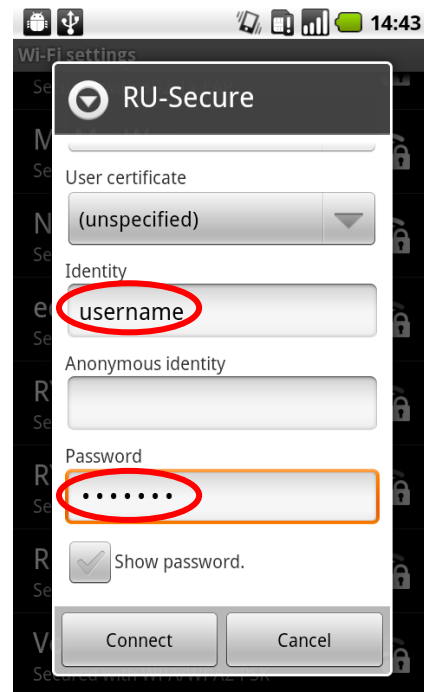
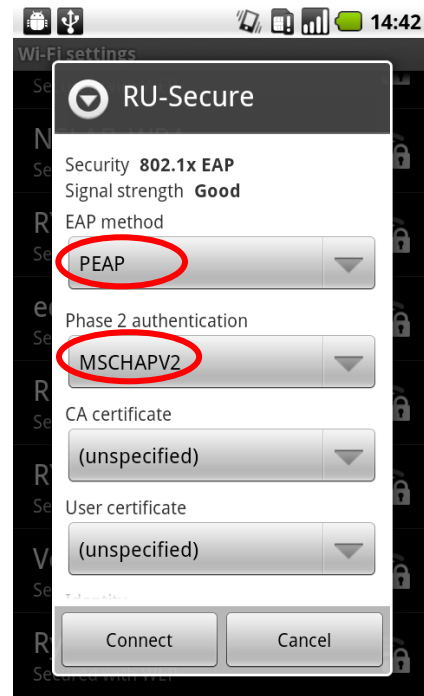
6. The connection options for the network will open. Please configure the settings as follows: (There are two screenshots as you will need to scroll down to complete all the settings)

- a. EAP type: **PEAP**
- b. Phase 2 Authentication: **MSCHAPv2**
- c. Identity: type in your username and
- d. Password: type in your password

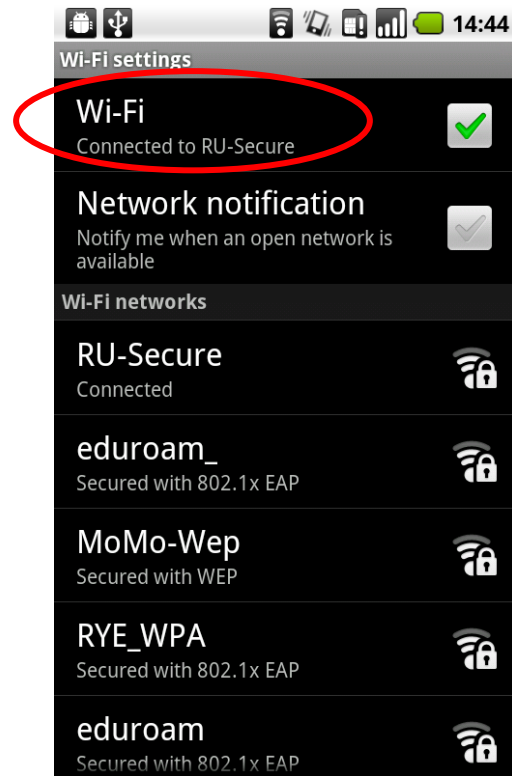
NOTE:

- i. **Students/Faculty:** Use your **my.ryerson** credentials
- ii. **Staff:** Use your **CFAPS** credentials

7. Click **Connect** and your settings will be applied.



8. Your device will now attempt to connect to the wireless network. After a few moments you should see “**Connected to RU-Secure**” under the Wi-Fi area.
9. You will now be connected to the **RU-Secure** network.



Your Android device will be automatically logged on when within range of the signal.
