

BESTSELLING AUTHOR CHRIS TURNER MAKES THE CASE FOR A GERMAN-STYLE SHIFT TOWARDS RENEWABLE ENERGY

Lecture to outline the key lessons for Ontario and its own energy transition now well underway

TORONTO, Nov. 7, 2013 – Chris Turner, bestselling author of *The War on Science, The Leap and The Geography of Hope*, will discuss the lessons that Ontario can learn from Germany and its trailblazing move to renewable energy at a lecture on **Saturday, Nov. 9**, Mattamy Athletic Centre, 3pm.

For more than a decade, Germany has been engaged in the most ambitious sustainability shift of any major industrial nation - a move to renewable energy and hyper-efficiency now known in German as the *Energiewende* (Energy Transition). Germany's pursuit of a low-carbon future is a case study for any community hoping to follow the same path.

<u>Chris Turner</u>, journalist, author, renowned sustainability expert and Ryerson alumnus, has been studying the *Energiewende* almost since it began, and in 'Tracking The German Leap', he takes a look at Germany's leap in mid-flight, sizing up the successes and setbacks, as well as outlining key lessons for Ontario and its own energy transition now well underway.

The lecture will be followed by a Q&A moderated by <u>Sean Conway</u>, distinguished research fellow at Ryerson University's Centre for Urban Energy. Turner will be available for media requests following the lecture.
