The Pierre Lassonde Entrance Awards are open to students **entering the first year (Common Year) of a Ryerson Engineering program**, and who meet the criteria listed below.

**Deadline: May 15, 2012**

**Eligibility**

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Enrolled full-time in the first year of an engineering program at Ryerson University.
- Demonstrated academic accomplishment with a minimum 85% overall average in final year of high school.
- Canadian citizen, permanent resident or protected person.
- Resident of Ontario.
- Demonstrated financial need through the completion of a Student Budget Form.

**Application Process**

- Completion of an Application Form, a one to two page letter outlining academic accomplishments and leadership qualities, Student Budget Form and a signed FIPPA Statement.

**Weighting of Criteria**

**Selection**

The selection of the award recipients will be conducted by the Office of the Dean, Faculty of Engineering, Architecture and Science, based on the weighted criteria. The award funds will be deposited to students' tuition fee accounts in August 2012.
