Syd Perlmutter Entrance Award

School of Radio & Television Arts

The Award

Honours the achievements of Professor Emeritus Syd Perlmutter, one of the pioneers of the Radio & Television Arts program at Ryerson University. The award is available to students entering their first year in the Radio & Television Arts program at Ryerson University.

Award Type

One annual award of \$3,000.00 per academic year.

Eligibility & Application Information

To be eligible for this award, students must:

- Be currently enrolled full-time (minimum of three Ontario grade 12 U/M courses or Canadian provincial equivalent within the regular school year) in a Canadian secondary school; have been continuously enrolled full-time (no-gaps in full-time attendance prior to the regular school year); be enrolling in a postsecondary institution for the first time; have submitted an active application to a full-time undergraduate four year degree Radio & Television Arts program at Ryerson via the Ontario Universities' Application Centre (OUAC) application process by May 1.
- Demonstrate financial need as determined by Ryerson University through completion of a budget form.
- Demonstrate how they believe that their role in media can make a difference within the community and society.

Completed Application must include:

- A two page application letter outlining their commitment to the Radio & Television Arts field and why they feel their role in media can make a difference.
- Budget form (to determine financial need).

Application Letter and Budget Form are to be emailed to rta@ryerson.ca by the end of the business day, Monday, April 16, 2012.

Renewal Terms

The Award is renewable each year for a maximum of up to 4 years provided:

- A 3.00 CGPA is maintained;
- A full-time course load of 80% (4 units) is carried both in the fall and winter semesters with clear academic standing;
- A new budget is submitted at the start of each academic year demonstrating financial need.
