Pivotal Projects Award

The Pivotal Projects Award will be a financial award to a 2nd, 3rd or 4th year undergraduate student enrolled in Architectural Science (Project Management Stream), or Civil, Electrical and Mechanical Engineering in the Faculty of Engineering and Architectural Science who has high academic standing and demonstrates excellence in project management.

Eligibility and Application Process

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Have an overall record of academic excellence, as demonstrated by a minimum CGPA of 3.67
- Be an Undergraduate student in the Faculty of Engineering and Architectural Science
- Be enrolled in one of the following programs: Architectural Science (Project management Stream), Civil, Electrical and Mechanical Engineering
- Be enrolled in 2nd, 3rd or 4th year
- Application letter (max. of 200 words) outlining the student's strengths in academic areas related to project management

Criteria for Selection

Academic Excellence (CGPA: 3.67)	50%
Application Letter	50%

Adjudication

The Awards Selection Committee will be composed of at least three representatives from the Faculty of Engineering and Architectural Science and the Dean. The Awards Selection Committee will review the application, and make the final selection of the recipient.
