Occupational Health and Safety Act

The Occupational Health and Safety Act (OHSA) provides you with the right to a safe work environment. It sets out roles for employers, supervisors and workers so they can work together to make workplaces safer.

If you are injured on campus

1. In an emergency or if you require immediate medical assistance, call 911.

- **2. In a non-emergency**, you can also seek assistance from your department's First Aider.
- 3. Notify your supervisor or faculty.
- **4. Cooperate with your supervisor or faculty** in completing TMU's Internal Incident Form, which can be found at **torontomu.ca/report-incident-injury**.
- 5. If your injury requires medical care or time off work, your supervisor or faculty must complete the WSIB Form 7 which can be found at torontomu.ca/reportincident-injury.
