3. STATEMENT OF INTEREST

- The Statement of Interest should be approximately 500 words in length. Two copies of the Statement of Interest are required.
- The Statement of Interest should describe your reasons for pursuing graduate study in the Psychology program, your research interests, how your previous studies and experience have prepared you for the program, your career objectives and how the graduate degree will advance them. You should also mention up to four or five possible supervisors with whom you might be interested in working
- If there are aspects of your application that you want to explain (e.g., lower grades during a particular term), this can be done in the Statement of Interest as well.
- The Statement of Interest is used by the Admissions Committee to determine that the applicant has been able to identify an area of research relevant to the program, and whether an appropriate match can be made to a faculty advisor/supervisor. It is possible that a highly qualified applicant will not be admitted if there are no possible thesis/project faculty advisors available to work in the areas of interest identified in the application. Therefore, applicants should make themselves familiar with the research within the program when considering which area of interest to pursue as a graduate student.

4. CURRICULUM VITAE OR RÉSUMÉ

Please submit a current curriculum vitae highlighting your education, work experience, skills, awards, publications, professional presentations, memberships in professional associations, and other relevant details.

5. LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

A minimum of two Letters of Recommendation are required for each application (3 letters are preferred). Applicants to the Clinical Psychology Field should also have their references complete the **Supplementary Reference Form for Applicants to Clinical Psychology**.

The letters of recommendations should be from academic referees – former professors or research supervisors familiar with the applicant's abilities. One recommendation may be substituted with a professional letter from a previous employer.

IMPORTANT!

A new online referee portal is now available for the fall 2012 session. You will be asked to complete the referee page on the online application form with their contact information including an active institution e-mail address. Your referees will be contacted electronically within 5-7 business days of your application submission with further instructions.

Reference letters are a key component of your application package and a close attention must be paid prior to selecting a referee. It is also your responsibility to contact the referee before filling out the online application form to confirm their availability.

Please note that we reserve the right to contact your referees at any stage during the application process.
