- 1. The length of the teaching term in each semester is 12 weeks, except in engineering programs where it is 13 weeks.
- 2. Registration and student orientation for Undergraduate programs will be held each year during the week preceding Labour Day.
- 3. Undergraduate Program classes begin on the Tuesday after Labour Day.
- 4. There will be no examinations or tests scheduled in the last week of the Fall and Winter semesters, or on the Saturday or Sunday before the examination period.
- 5. Study weeks will be held on the weeks including Thanksgiving Day and Family Day.
- 6. The Winter Term Examination Period will normally end by April 30. Due to final exam period time constraints, Ryerson finds it necessary to schedule final exams on Saturdays.
- 7. The reporting of final grades will normally be done within one week of the end of the examination period.
