

Post-baccalaureate CERTIFICATE in Public Administration and Leadership

Eligible students who completed, as part of their undergraduate program, courses in Governance/Government, Political Science, Public Policy, or Public Administration will be admitted directly to the Certificate.

Eligible students who without any background in the discipline will be required to complete successfully *COPA103: Canadian Public Administration*, a one-semester *non-credit* course which will be offered in the Spring/Summer term via Distance Education.
