

FRANK H. HORI AWARD FOR ABORIGINAL STUDENTS

Created by the trustees of The Frank H. Hori Charitable Foundation, this award recognizes two Aboriginal students, with financial need at Ryerson University, for their academic achievements and their connection to the Aboriginal Community.

Two (2) awards of \$5000 each are available to be distributed in the Fall semester.

Eligibility:

Students can apply if they are:

- Canadian citizen, permanent resident or a protected person.
- Self-identify as an Aboriginal person (including First Nations [Status/Non-Status], Metis, or Inuit cultural and/or ancestral background).
- Officially enrolled and attending classes in any full-time undergraduate degree program or graduate studies program, or post-graduate program in the 2018-19 academic year.
- Demonstrate financial need as determined by Ryerson University through completion of the provided budget submission template.
- Have a minimum Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 2.0 or higher and a clear academic standing.
- Provide a written statement/essay (1,200 word maximum) describing their connection to their Aboriginal community.

 - Note: If the provided Budget form does NOT adequately reflect your personal circumstance in terms of either expenses or resources, please complete it as best you can and include any additional information about your expenses/income as needed on a separate page.
 - *This information will be taken into account during our assessment for eligibility – please be clear and reflect the format provided in the budget template.*
- FIPPA Statement signed and completed
- Personal Statement/Essay (1200 words maximum) – describing your connection to your Aboriginal community

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- The personal statement/essay component is an important part of the application and selection process for this award. This award has been developed to recognize and support Aboriginal students with financial need, for both their academic achievements and connections to their Aboriginal community. Personal statements/essays should focus on these elements and showcase why the student is an excellent candidate for this award.
