



### **ACS950: Directed Research Course**

This course offers students the opportunity for advanced study with a professor in the Faculty of Arts. Topics are determined jointly by the student and professor. Normally, students must have completed at least 25 credits before taking ACS950, and have a CGPA no less than 3.0. Students must submit a completed application form to the ACS Program Office at least 20 business days before the start of the relevant semester. Departmental and Program Consent Required.

### **ACS950: Policies and Procedures**

- Eligible students may take this course in lieu of either ACS800 or ACS900. Eligible students may take this course in addition to either or both of ACS800 and ACS900.
- Normally, only RFA members in the Faculty of Arts are permitted to supervise a directed research course.
- No faculty member shall be obliged, or made to feel obliged, to supervise a directed research course.
- Requests for a directed research course in a given area of study should first be submitted by the student to the Chair of the relevant department.
- The consent of the relevant instructor, that individual's Chair, and the ACS Program Director, is required.
- No student may complete more than one directed research course.
- Students must complete the application form below by the deadline noted.
- Copies of the application form will be kept on file by the ACS Program office, the relevant departmental office, and the relevant instructor.
- The evaluation scheme (number and nature of assignments required) must be comparable to other advanced undergraduate courses in the Faculty of Arts.
- Deviations from the agreed-upon evaluation scheme must be approved in writing by the student, the instructor, the relevant Chair, and the ACS Program Director.
- In agreeing to serve as a supervisor, the faculty member understands that, at the present time, teaching ACS950 will not be considered part of his/her normal teaching workload, and there will be no compensation provided.
- Normally, instructors will not be permitted to supervise more than one student per semester.
