## Program Course Restrictions

Students wishing to pursue an Option (see Professional Table I) must make their choice by the end of 2nd semester. Once an Option has been chosen, students must complete all the requirements of that Option to graduate. Individual requirements for the nine Options are identified in Table I. Students can change or choose an option in later semesters as well, provided they consult with the program department.

\* Students pursuing the Anthropology Studies Option must take ACS 106 in 2nd semester. FRE & SPN courses are available to Anthropology Studies Option on Tables I, II, A and/or B. Students are not allowed to Major and Minor in the same field of study (i.e. History Option and History Minor).

Students who choose to major in a subject specific option (i.e. English, History, Philosophy, and/or French) cannot choose Liberal Studies (Table A and B) within the same discipline.

## Important Information

- After you enroll in courses, check RAMSS for your timetable.
- Classes are scheduled weekly as a three hour lecture OR two hour lecture and one hour tutorial.
