TEMPORARINESS: Employment and transitions challenges for highly skilled temporary workers

Help us better understand the challenges that you face, as either an international student or holder of a temporary work permit, in your pursuit of employment or permanent residence status.

Eligibility criteria:

- study permit holders
- post-graduate work permit holders
- highly-skilled temporary work permit holders
- 18 years of age and older
- · living in Canada

In-depth interview details:

- participants will be asked questions on their educational qualifications and professional background, experiences as a temporary foreign worker, and/or international graduate student in Canada, their perceptions on the transition to permanent resident status, and their labour market integration experience in Canada
- interviews will take place online via Zoom and last approx. 1 2 hours
- · all information provided during the interview will be considered confidential
- · participants can withdraw their consent at any point in the process
- · participants will receive a \$25 Walmart gift card
- · a total of 30 interviews will be conducted
- · participant data may be used for future research
