The Second Chance Award in Criminal Justice

Department of Criminology Faculty of Arts

Purpose

To recognize the academic achievement of an undergraduate student in the Department of Criminology who has overcome personal, social and/or economic disadvantage to pursue their course of study. The **Second Chance Award in Criminal Justice** will be awarded to one undergraduate student in the BA program in Criminology.

Award Amount

The endowed funds will provide one annual award. The actual amount will be dependent upon the income generated throughout the previous year.

Award Renewal

This is a non-renewable award. Previous award winners are eligible to apply provided they remain in good academic standing.

Application Deadline

August 15 of each year (or January 15 in years when a suitable candidate is not found in the August competition).

Eligibility & Application Information

- Must be a Canadian citizen, a Permanent Resident, or a Protected Person.
- Must be an Ontario Resident.
- Must demonstrate financial need as determined by Ryerson University.
- Applicants must be newly admitted to the BA program in Criminology or be a student in good standing in the program (i.e., not on academic probation). Preference will be given to newly admitted students.
- Applicants must demonstrate how they have overcome personal, social and/or economic disadvantage in order to pursue their course of study. They must also describe why they are pursuing criminal justice studies and what career, academic and/or community service goals they have for the future.
- Applicant should write, in confidence, to the Department Chair, naming The Second Chance Award in Criminal Justice and explaining how they meet the Award criteria.

Applicants Are Required to Supply:

- A three to four page cover letter describing why they are an ideal candidate. The letter must include information regarding how the applicant has overcome personal, social and/or economic disadvantage to pursue their course of study. It must also describe why they are pursuing Criminal Justice Studies and what career, academic and/or community service goals they have for the future.
- Resume.
- Two letters of support.
- Completed Student Application and Student Budget Form.

Weighting of Criteria

Cover Letter	35%
Resume	15%
Letters of Support	<u>15%</u>

Selection

The selection committee will be composed of at least two faculty members of the Department of Criminology. They will review the weighted criteria (see above). The Committee will prepare a ranked list of qualified Award recipients and will make the final selection of the recipient based on the weighted criteria.

If in the opinion of the selection committee that no applicants meet the outlined criteria in the August competition, a January competition will be held. If a suitable candidate is not found in the January competition, the Department will not make an award for that academic year.
