

ZONTA Award in Memory of Marlene Simmonds

Purpose

To recognize the academic achievement of one full-time female student in the Department of Criminology entering their fourth year of study in the program.

Award Value

The actual amount will be dependent upon the income generated throughout the previous year.

Application Deadline

September 30 or as posted.

Eligibility/Criteria

OTSS Requirements

- Students must be Canadian citizens, permanent residents or protected persons.
- Students must be Ontario residents.
- Students must demonstrate financial need as determined by Ryerson University through completion of a detailed budget submission in accordance with OTSS guidelines.

Faculty/School Requirements

- Students must be female.
- Students must have successfully completed three years of study in the Criminology Program and be in clear academic standing.
- The applicant should write, in confidence, to the Department of Criminology, naming “The Zonta Award in Memory of Marlene Simmonds” and explaining how she meets the award criteria and has demonstrated interest in the area of improvement of the social, economic and legal status of women through their related outreach/volunteer activities and through their proposed studies in the fourth year.

Interested candidates will need to supply:

- One-page cover letter describing why they are an ideal candidate.
- Resume.
