For second or third-year students enrolled full-time in an Engineering program and are pursuing the Optional Specialization in Management Sciences (OSMS), are in clear academic standing and have demonstrated academic excellence and financial need.

Eligibility and Application Process Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Have a record of clear academic standing
- Demonstrated academic excellence, minimum CGPA of 3.33
- Demonstrate financial need through the submission of a budget statement (https://www.ryerson.ca/content/dam/registrar/pdfs/SFA_Budget.pdf)
- Be a Canadian citizen or a Landed Immigrant and be a resident of the Province of Ontario
- Students must submit a 1 to 2 page covering letter to the Dean outlining academic accomplishments and leadership qualities

Criteria for Selection

Criteria	Weighting
Financial Need	50%
Academic Accomplishment (minimum CGPA of 3.33)	40%
Leadership	10%

Adjudication

The selection of the Award recipients will be conducted by the Office of the Dean, Faculty of Engineering and Architectural Science, based on the weighted criteria.
