Stalin Boctor Circuits Award

The Award provides financial support for a student who has demonstrated financial need and academic excellence in course/courses focused on electrical circuits.

Eligibility and Application Process

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be enrolled in a full-time program in the Faculty of Engineering and Architectural Science;
- Demonstrate overall success in their studies with a CGPA of 3.0 or higher and have clear academic standing;
- Demonstrate academic excellence in course/courses focused on electrical circuits;
- Demonstrate financial need as determined by Ryerson University through completion of a detailed budget submission in accordance with OTSS guidelines;

- Be a Canadian Citizen, a Permanent Resident or a Protected Person; Be an Ontario resident.

Criteria for Selection

| Criteria | Weighting |
|-------------------------------------|------------------|
| Budget/Financial Need | 50% |
| CGPA, Academic Standing | 25% |
| Grade in Electrical Circuits Course | 25% |

Adjudication

The Awards Selection Committee will be composed of at least three representatives from the Faculty of Engineering and Architectural Science and the Dean. The Awards Selection Committee will review the application, and make the final selection of the recipient.

If in the opinion of the selection committee that no applicants meet the outlined criteria, the award shall not be given to any applicant that year.
