Stalin Boctor Graduating Student Award

The Award provides financial assistance for a student who has demonstrated financial need and academic excellence in their fourth year of studies in the Faculty of Engineering and Architectural Science (FEAS).

Eligibility and Application Process

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be enrolled in a full-time Masters program in the Faculty of Engineering and Architectural Science
- Have completed an undergraduate degree from the Faculty of Engineering and Architectural Science at Ryerson University;
- Demonstrate overall success in their studies with a cumulative CGPA of 3.0 or higher and have clear academic standing;
- Demonstrate financial need as determined by Ryerson University through completion of a detailed budget submission in accordance with OTSS guidelines;
- Be a Canadian Citizen, a Permanent Resident or a Protected Person;
- Be an Ontario resident;
- Demonstrate academic excellence in the fourth year of undergraduate studies in Engineering or Architectural Science.

Adjudication

The Awards Selection Committee will be comprised of at least three representatives from the Faculty of Engineering and Architectural Science and the Dean. The Awards Selection Committee will review the applications and make the final selection of the recipient based on the weighted criteria.

If in the opinion of the selection committee that no applicants meet the outlined criteria, the award shall not be given to any applicant that year.
