

Bruce Beauchamp Memorial Award

1 award of \$1,000

APPLICATION DEADLINE: (October 5, 2018)

This award recognizes an undergraduate student registered in the Biology, Biomedical Science or Medical Physics program, who has completed their 3rd year, and who demonstrates academic and research excellence in the life sciences, with a priority given to excellence in cancer related knowledge and/or research.

Eligibility and Application Process

To be eligible for this award, students must:

- Be registered as a full-time undergraduate student in the Biology, Biomedical Science or Medical Physics program in the Faculty of Science at Ryerson University and have **clear academic standing**.
- Have a minimum CGPA of 3.0 at the end of 3rd year

Application Information:

A completed application must include:

Application letter (250-500 words) outlining demonstrated research excellence in the life sciences, with priority given to cancer research, such as an NSERC Undergraduate Research Assistantship, other lab research assistant positions, participation in a research symposia or conference such as the Chemistry and Biology Summer Symposium, or other relevant experience.

Letter of recommendation from a faculty member in support of research activities

Weighting of Criteria

Criteria	Weighting
Personal Statement	50%
Letter of recommendation	50%

Adjudication

The selection committee will be composed of at least three representatives from Deans Office, FOS at Ryerson University. They will review the application information and prepare a ranked list of qualified Award recipients. They will make the final selection of the recipient based on the weighted criteria. If in the opinion of the selection committee that no candidates meet the outlined criteria, the award shall not be given to any applicant that year.
