

Geoff Boyes International Student Leadership Award

Faculty of Science

2 awards of \$2,000 each

Award for 2nd, 3rd and 4th year undergraduate students enrolled in a full-time program in the Faculty of Science

APPLICATION DEADLINE: (October 5, 2018)

The Award is named in memory of Geoff Boyes, a retired Math professor who passed away in 2014. Geoff remembered Ryerson in his will with a legacy gift. Geoff recognized the financial hardships that international students faced while pursuing post-secondary education.

Eligibility and Application Process

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be registered as an undergraduate, full-time student at Ryerson University and have a clear academic standing;
- Be an international student (does not have Canadian citizenship)
- Be registered in programs within the Faculty of Science
- Be enrolled in the second, third or fourth year of their program
- Demonstrated financial need, as determined by Ryerson University, through submission of a Student Budget Form.

Criteria for Selection

- A written statement of 250 words outlining leadership and community building contributions to the Faculty of Science community.
- One letter of support from a Ryerson faculty, staff or community member that speaks to the impact of the applicant on the criteria above.

Criteria Weighting (%)

Written Statement	55%
Letter of Support	45%

Adjudication

The award will be administered by Faculty of Science, Office of the Dean. The selection committee will be composed of at least three representatives from Faculty of Science at Ryerson University. They will review the application information and prepare a ranked list of qualified Award recipients. They will make the final selection of the recipient based on the weighted criteria. If in the opinion of the selection committee that no candidates meet the outlined criteria, the award shall not be given to any applicant that year.
