Master of Health Administration in Community Care MHA(CC)

This full-time Master program will be offered by the School of Health Services Management (SHSM), in the Ted Rogers School of Management (TRSM), Ryerson University. The Ryerson Master of Health Administration in Community Care (MHA(CC)) will be the first program in Canada to offer a graduate degree in community health administration and management. The MHA(CC) will address the demand for skilled managers in private, public and not-for-profit organizations that plan, coordinate, and deliver clinical and supportive healthcare in the community. The program leverages the SHSM's current capabilities developed over more than two decades of delivering a degree-completion Bachelor of Health Administration (BHA), part-time to health care professionals. As a growing number of potential candidates hold undergraduate degrees, the SHSM has naturally progressed to offer a graduate degree to sustain its vision to be a national leader in flexible and innovative management education and applied research for career health professionals.
