APA Format: Reference List

Take some time to pay attention to the details here:

- Brackets, punctuation, and italics are all important parts of APA formatting.
- Center the word “References” (do not bold, italicize, or use with quotation marks) at the top of your reference page.
- Order your references alphabetically.
