



## BOARD OF GOVERNORS ELECTION CONSTITUENCY AND CANDIDACY DESCRIPTIONS

### ALUMNI MEMBER ELECTION

<b>To VOTE,</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• must have received one or more degree, diploma, or certificate from Ryerson University or any of its predecessor institutions; and</li> <li>• must <u>not</u> be registered as a student in a program or course of study that leads to a degree, diploma, or certificate of Ryerson University.</li> </ul>
<b>To NOMINATE a candidate,</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• must be eligible to vote in the Alumni member election.</li> </ul>
<b>To be a CANDIDATE,</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• must be eligible to vote in the Alumni member election;</li> <li>• must <u>not</u> be an employee of Ryerson University;</li> <li>• must submit a satisfactorily completed nomination form (available at Board Election website at <a href="http://www.ryerson.ca/governors/elections">www.ryerson.ca/governors/elections</a>);</li> <li>• must be eighteen years of age or older;</li> <li>• must <u>not</u> be serving as a member of any other post-secondary institution's Board of Governors or similar body; and</li> <li>• be approved to run as a candidate by the Election Procedures Committee.</li> </ul>

### TEACHING FACULTY MEMBER ELECTION

<b>To VOTE,</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• must be a full-time tenured or probationary teaching faculty whose principal duties include research and/or teaching functions of the University, including employees holding the Offices of Dean, Chair, Assistant Chair of department, or Academic Director, where full-time employee is defined as a regular teaching faculty member or probationer, tenure stream and is not a Limited Term Faculty or CUPE member.</li> </ul>
<b>To NOMINATE a candidate,</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• must be eligible to vote in the Teaching Faculty member election.</li> </ul>
<b>To be a CANDIDATE,</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• must be eligible to vote in the Teaching Faculty member election;</li> <li>• submit a satisfactorily completed nomination form (available at Board Election website at <a href="http://www.ryerson.ca/governors/elections">www.ryerson.ca/governors/elections</a>);</li> <li>• must be eighteen years of age or older;</li> <li>• must <u>not</u> be serving as a member of any other post-secondary institution's Board of Governors or similar body; and</li> <li>• be approved to run as a candidate by the Election Procedures Committee.</li> </ul>

### ADMINISTRATIVE STAFF MEMBER ELECTION

<b>To VOTE,</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• must be a full-time employee of Ryerson University who is not a member of the teaching faculty and is serving in a regular capacity on a continuing basis where this is defined as either a full-time career employee or a term employee who has completed a minimum of 12 months of continuing employment for greater than 24 hours per week.</li></ul>
<b>To NOMINATE a candidate,</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• must be eligible to vote in the Administrative Staff member election.</li></ul>
<b>To be a CANDIDATE,</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• must be eligible to vote in the Administrative Staff member election;</li><li>• must submit a satisfactorily completed nomination form (available at Board Election website at <a href="http://www.ryerson.ca/governors/elections">www.ryerson.ca/governors/elections</a>);</li><li>• must <u>not</u> be serving as a member of any other post-secondary institution's Board of Governors or similar body;</li><li>• must be eighteen years of age or older; and</li><li>• must be approved to run as a candidate by the Election Procedures Committee.</li></ul>

### STUDENT MEMBER ELECTION

<b>To VOTE,</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• must be registered as a student in a program or course of study at Ryerson University that leads to a degree, diploma, or certificate of the University.</li></ul>
<b>To NOMINATE a candidate,</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• must be eligible to vote in the Student member election.</li></ul>
<b>To be a CANDIDATE,</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• must be eligible to vote in the Student member election;</li><li>• must satisfy the candidacy criteria referred to in the <a href="#">Election Policies</a> and Procedures Appendix A – February 28, 2012 Election Procedure Committee Appeal Panel decision (available at Board Election website at <a href="http://www.ryerson.ca/content/dam/about/governors/elections/2016/Election_Policies_and_Procedures_January_2016.pdf">http://www.ryerson.ca/content/dam/about/governors/elections/2016/Election_Policies_and_Procedures_January_2016.pdf</a>);</li><li>• must submit a satisfactorily completed nomination form (available at Board Election website at <a href="http://www.ryerson.ca/governors/elections">www.ryerson.ca/governors/elections</a>);</li><li>• must attend the Mandatory Student Nominees Session;</li><li>• is <u>not</u> required to be eighteen years of age or older;</li><li>• must <u>not</u> be serving as a member of any other post-secondary institution's Board of Governors or similar body; and</li><li>• must be approved to run as a candidate by the Election Procedures Committee.</li></ul>
