Undergraduate Students

Domestic tuition fees range from \$6,110 (for Arts & Science) to \$10,189 (for Engineering). International students pay between \$31,610 and \$36,750.

Graduate Students

Domestic tuition fees for Master's range from \$4,307 (for Communication & Culture) to \$21,630 (for the MBA). International students pay between \$24,260 and \$51,100.

Domestic tuition fees for a PhD range from \$4,307 (for Communication & Culture) to \$7,612 (for Engineering). All International students pay \$23,240.
Costs of books and supplies range from \$700 to \$1,500.
