Any time after completion of MWF 120	The Judith (Jude) Pustil Memorial Award	\$700	Oct 1	-must have relocated for clinical placement -criteria for excellent clinical performance

Any time after completion of MWF 120	The Emma Sykes Chandler Memorial Award	\$1000	Oct 1	-criteria to have demonstrated exemplary skills, compassion & caring during a challenging situation in a clinical course
Any time after completion of MWF 120	Judith Rachel Harris Perinatal Loss Award	\$1000	Oct 1	-criteria to have demonstrated an understanding of pregnancy loss and difficult transitions related to birth/midwifery care

Completed MWF 350	Murray and Eleanor Enkin Award for Social Justice	\$2000	May 15	-criteria to have demonstrated commitment to the community/MEP through contributions that promote social justice and human dignity
Completed MWF 315	Judith Rachel Harris Publication/Presentation Award	\$1000	May 15	-criteria to demonstrate excellence in a paper prepared for publication or evidence of acceptance of a presentation or poster at a professional conference

Completed MWF 320	Toronto Birth Centre Innovation Award	\$1325	Oct 1	-recipients can only receive one TBC Award while a student in the MEP

Completed MWF 420	Murray and Eleanor Enkin Midwifery Award for Clinical Excellence	\$2000	May 15	-criteria to have demonstrated excellent clinical performance in the MWF420 placement
Completed all requirements for graduation from the MEP	Murray and Eleanor Enkin Graduation Excellence Award	\$2500	Oct 1	-nomination by a preceptor or faculty member is required -criteria to have exemplified excellence in the caring, clinical and academic areas of midwifery practice -grade summaries for MWF 410 and MWF 420 must be submitted by the tutor directly to the Awards Committee
