Canadian Congress of Applied Mechanics Awards

To provide two awards for undergraduate students enrolled full time in the Mechanical Engineering program who demonstrate financial need and academic achievement in the study of (1) "Thermofluids" (one award) and (2) "Solid Mechanics" (one award) courses. Students must be enrolled full time in Mechanical Engineering.

Eligibility and Application Process

Applications must be submitted to the Mechanical and Industrial Engineering Department office in EPH 300 by the date and time stated on the Mechanical and Industrial Engineering Department website.

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be a Canadian Citizen, a Permanent Resident or a Protected Person;
- Be an Ontario resident;
- Demonstrate financial need as determined by Ryerson University through completion of a detailed budget submission in accordance with OTSS guidelines;
- Demonstrate overall excellence in their studies with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher;
- Academic achievement in the study of Thermofluids OR in courses related to Solid Mechanics
- Write a one-page letter of application explaining how they meet the criteria.

Criteria for Selection

Criteria	Weighting
Budget/Financial Need	50%
Academic Excellence (CGPA 3.0 or higher)	<u>50%</u>

Adjudication

The Department of Mechanical and Industrial Engineering Awards Committee will recommend the name of a candidate to the Chair for final selection. All prospective recipients of the award must complete a detailed budget that demonstrates financial need.

Please submit an APPLICATION LETTER outlining how you meet the criteria and include the completed Student Budget, in a sealed envelope addressed to the Chair, Department of Mechanical and Industrial Engineering, EPH 300.
