Michael Poczo Jr. Memorial Award

The Michael Poczo Jr. Memorial Award recognizes academic achievement, entrepreneurial thought, leadership and drive; in addition to demonstrated financial need.

Eligibility and Application Process

Applications must be submitted to the Mechanical and Industrial Engineering Department office in EPH 300 by the date and time stated on the Mechanical and Industrial Engineering Department website.

Eligibility

Students must meet the following criteria:

- Be a Canadian Citizen, a Permanent Resident or a Protected Person;
- Be an Ontario resident;
- Demonstrate financial need as determined by Ryerson University through completion of a detailed budget submission in accordance with OTSS guidelines;
- Have a record of academic excellence, as demonstrated by a minimum CGPA of 2.5
- A brief written submission demonstrating entrepreneurial spirit, professionalism, and dedication to family, friends and colleagues
- A letter of reference from a faculty member that confirms the focus of their work in the field of Mechanical Engineering

Adjudication

The Department of Mechanical and Industrial Engineering Awards Committee will recommend the names of candidates to the Chair for final selection. All prospective recipients of the award must complete a detailed budget that demonstrates financial need.

Please submit an APPLICATION LETTER and a FACULTY REFERENCE LETTER outlining how you meet the criteria and include the completed Student Budget in a sealed envelope addressed to the Department of Mechanical and Industrial Engineering, EPH 300.
