The Ron Wayman Rotary Award provides financial assistance and recognizes the extra-curricular achievement of a student in the Mechanical and Industrial Engineering Department at Ryerson University in memory of Ron Wayman.

Eligibility and Application Information

Applications must be submitted to the Mechanical and Industrial Engineering Department office in EPH 300 by the date and time stated on the Mechanical and Industrial Engineering Department website.

To be eligible for this award, students must:

- Be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student in second, third or fourth year in the Mechanical and Industrial Engineering program.
- Have a clear academic standing.
- Have a minimum CGPA of 3.0.
- Demonstrate financial need as determined by Ryerson University through completion of a detailed budget submission in accordance with OTSS guidelines.
- Demonstrate above average involvement in the community, demonstrating high ethical standard and 'service above self'.

A completed application must include:

- Application letter (maximum length 500 words) highlighting participation in professional affairs, community involvement and extra-curricular activities demonstrating high ethical standards and 'service above self'.
- Budget form (to determine financial need).
