



Bill 7 Award LGBTQ Scholarship

What is the Bill 7 Award?

The Bill 7 Award is a charitable trust that awards scholarships to gay, lesbian, bisexual, transgender, transsexual, queer and two-spirited students that are residents in Ontario.

The Bill 7 Award scholarship is named after the 1986 legislation that extended the protection of the Ontario Human Rights Code to prohibit discrimination on the basis of sexual orientation.

Who Can Apply?

Any student who identifies as gay, lesbian, bisexual, transgender, transsexual, queer or two-spirited, who demonstrates a financial need and who is attending or accepted by a post-secondary educational institution in Ontario to pursue their first post-secondary program of study.

Scholarship Details

In 2021, the Bill 7 Award Trust will be awarding at least 17 scholarships of \$3,500 each.

Applications Open: Mid-April to May 1, 2021

Application Deadline: August 6, 2021
