MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIR

Welcome to the second **Annual Research and Achievement Report** for the Department of Psychology at Ryerson University, highlighting contributions for the 2012-2013 academic year. The accomplishments of our faculty, postdoctoral fellows, and students comprise over 50 pages of diverse contributions spanning all major areas of Psychology, as well as a number of related fields. The report includes awards, honours, grants, publications, presentations, media interviews, and various other contributions over the previous year.

Here are some highlights of the report, which includes contributions from June 2012 through May 2013:

Summary of Research Accomplishments

- 29 prestigious external awards and honors, including “new investigator” and “career” awards from the Canadian Psychological Association and the Canadian Society for Brain, Behaviour, and Cognitive Science
- 4 appointments to “fellow” status in national and international psychology associations
- Several senior editorial appointments (e.g., editor, associate editor) to scientific journals such as the *Journal of Consulting and Clinical Psychology* and *Canadian Acoustics*
- 38 new external research grants, totaling more than \$4.2 million in funding
- 116 peer reviewed journal publications
- 49 books and book chapters published
- 16 other publications
- 232 poster and conference presentations
- 99 workshops, invited lectures, and colloquia

Undergraduate Program

- We received 3195 applications for Fall 2012 admission to our BA program. A total of 125 students were admitted, with a mean incoming average of 86.4% (our highest ever). All incoming students were eligible for entrance scholarships based on their grades.

- In August 2012, the Psychology Students’ Association held its second annual Psychology Day, a welcome day for incoming first year psychology students to meet one another and upper year students.
- In April 2013, our Undergraduate Honours Thesis Poster Session was held, showcasing 20 different research projects conducted by students registered in the thesis stream option of our undergraduate program.

Graduate Program

- We received close to 300 applications for Fall 2012 admission to our MA/PhD program. 16 new students were admitted across our Psychological Science and Clinical Psychology streams.
- Ryerson’s Clinical Psychology Doctoral Program was accredited by the Canadian Psychological Association in Fall 2012.
- Our second cohort of 10 clinical psychology students matched for their predoctoral internships in February 2013. Despite an 84% success rate across Canada, 100% of Ryerson University students matched with an internship placement for the second year in a row.
- In October 2012, the Psychology Graduate Students’ Association hosted their annual Psychology Research Symposium, an event celebrating the research of the department’s current graduate students. Keynote speaker, Dr. Sandra Trehub (University of Toronto) spoke on the effects of maternal singing on infants, after which the event continued with several graduate student talks and a well attended poster session featuring graduate student research in the Department.

Other Highlights

- In August 2012, the Department welcomed Dr. Karen Milligan to Ryerson University, where she is now an assistant professor and Director of our Child Self-Regulation Lab. Previously, she served as Director of Research at Integra (Canada's only accredited mental health centre for children with mental health issues and co-occurring learning disabilities).
- The Department welcomed two new staff members: First, Carson Pun joined us in September 2012 as our new Research Operations Administrator. In this role, Carson provides research support and training at the Psychology Research and Training Centre. Second, Dr. Kelly Horner joined us in early 2013 as the Director of our Psychology Training Clinic, located in the Department of Family and Community Medicine at St. Michael's Hospital.
- Psychology offered 61 courses through the Chang School of Continuing Education, including our 8-course Certificate in Psychology, our 10-Course certificate in Mental Health and Addictions, and 6-course Interprofessional Certificate in Advanced Neuroscience and Stroke Care (as well as various standalone courses). 3087 students enrolled in our CE courses last year.
- In June 2013, we held our annual Psychology Research and Awards Celebration was held at the Arts and Letters Club of Toronto where over 120 of our undergraduate and graduate students were honoured with various internal and external awards.
- In Fall 2012, the Psychology Research and Training Centre expanded from about 10,000 square feet to about 15,000 square feet. The newly constructed space included several new research labs, as well as 10 rooms comprising our Institute for Stress and Wellbeing Research. The Stress Institute is supported by more than \$1 million in new research infrastructure, including funding from the Ontario Ministry of Research and Innovation, Ryerson University, and a generous donation from Harry Rosen to support faculty and graduate student research projects in the Institute. New equipment includes facilities for research in electrophysiology (e.g., EEG/ERP), neuroimaging (fNIRS), psychophysiology (e.g., EMG, GSR), eye-tracking, hormonal assay, and virtual reality.
- In July 2012, St. Michael's Hospital's Family Academic Health Team (which includes Ryerson's Psychology Training Clinic) was named by the Council of the Federation Working Group on Health Care Innovation as one of four leading Canadian models for team-based health care.
- Psychology Department members were quoted in well over 100 media outlets, including *ABC News*, *CBC News*, *CBS News*, *CNN*, *Discovery Channel*, *Globe and Mail*, *Huffington Post*, *Los Angeles Times*, *NBC News*, *New York Times*, *Toronto Star*, *US News and World Report*, and *Washington Post*, to name a few.

On behalf of my co-editors and the entire Department of Psychology, we hope you find this report to be informative, and we look forward to sharing the current year's accomplishments in our next report, scheduled for publication by Fall 2014!
