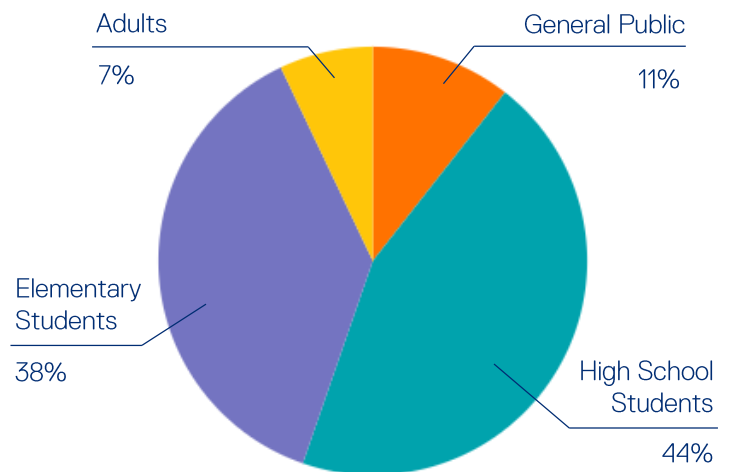
86 events hosted that amounted to 255 hours of science communication

Distribution of groups our events were geared towards



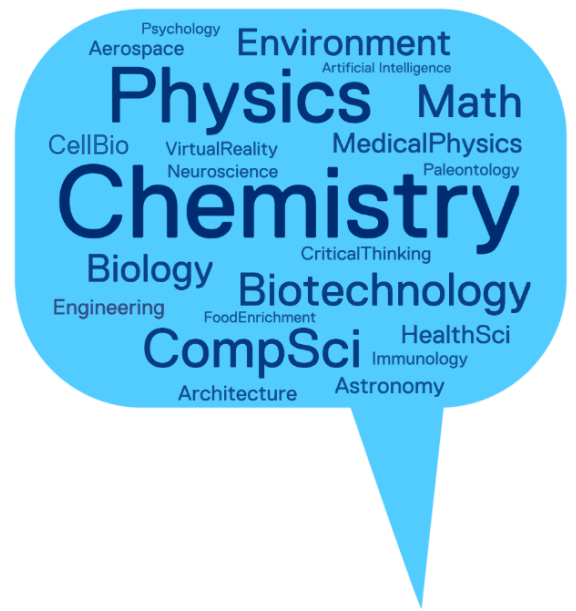
100% of our events are free and we reached ages 5 to 65+
