This Sector is Growing Exponentially

The hotel industry in Canada brings in over \$11B in revenue a year and is expected to have grown by close to 27% in 2021. ²

The global tourism marketplace, a similar good news story is appearing. In a market worth over \$11 trillion a year, growth in the next 5 years is going to take off. According to industry reports, this sector will see close to a 10% increase over the next 5 years.³
