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Certifications & Softwares in the Real Estate Industry

As a Real Estate Management student, you will take courses in Real Estate Finance, Sustainability in Real Estate, Real Estate Valuation and Real Estate Development. These courses will prepare you for opportunities within the industry - examples include as Housing and Commercial Property, Real Estate Finance, Property Development, Economics, Sustainability and Real Estate Law.

Many of these courses talk about software platforms and Certifications used in the industry including Microsoft Excel, LEED, Simply Analytics, and the Altus Group Guide.

Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED)



LEED sets the standards for sustainable construction and operation of buildings. It assesses various aspects of a building's design, construction, and operations, encouraging real estate developers to adopt environmentally friendly practices.

The LEED Certification promotes green and energy efficient buildings reducing carbon footprint and cutting energy costs.

It is a globally recognized and widely used rating system developed by the United States Green Building Council (USGBC), which focuses on designing, constructing, operating and providing certifications to buildings that focus strongly on sustainability, energy efficiency and the environment.

Within the Real Estate industry, LEED is a very important concept and below are several reasons why.



Sustainability - LEED promotes environmentally friendly practices such as renewable energy, water conservation, waste management and use of sustainable materials. Through LEED, many buildings have reduced their carbon footprint.



Energy Efficiency - LEED promotes strong energy efficiency and operation which has led to lower consumption of energy, reduced greenhouse gas emissions which has significantly reduced the costs of building and occupants.



Promotion of Health and Well-being - LEED certified buildings focus on providing indoor environmental quality such as natural lighting, better air quality and spaces for occupants, leading to higher productivity, and improved health and wellbeing for individuals in these spaces.
