



Top Technical Skills

Using Lightcast as our source, we collected data from 2,944 postings and uncovered the top skills employers are looking for in applicants for Business Analyst postings.




As we can clearly see, Microsoft Excel, SQL, and Microsoft PowerPoint are the most demanded technical skills - JIRA, Visio and Power BI, and Tableau are also in the top ten.

Based on these same job postings, it was clear that the ability to communicate, manage yourself and others, and solve problems was most desired among employers active in hiring Business Analysts.




Top Soft Skills for Business Analyst, based on Job Postings
